Why not join the Hastings Choristers? New members will be most welcome if you come along to this hall on Monday night at 7 pm.

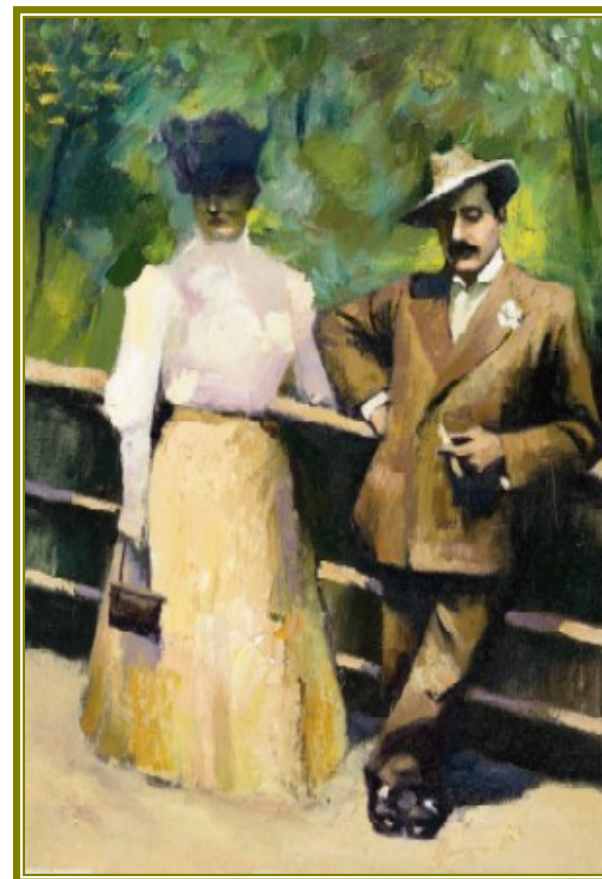

Born in Sydney, Nina completed a BA in Music at UWS, majoring in solo voice performance. She gained first place in the Penrith Eisteddfod in Under 25 Musical Theatre and second place in German Leider, before performing solo at the Festival of Cultures in the Sydney Opera House.



Marriage brought Nina to Port Macquarie, where she sang in the Master Class at the Hastings Choral Festival and met Robyn Ryan. Robyn persuaded Nina to join both Cantorus and Cantabile and she has since performed with these groups many times, singing several solo parts.

John has also performed with the Port Macquarie Players and Manning Arts Council, being particularly prolific in the 1970's and 1980's. He has also given recitals both locally and interstate.

He has performed leading roles in six Port Macquarie musicals, most recently appearing as the Pirate King in *Pirates of Penzance*.

Ian currently teaches music at St. Columbus Anglican School and the Academy of Music in Port Macquarie. He is also writing a book on singing and produces educational singing materials for teachers.

Julie began her study of classical guitar with Don Andrews in 1982 and completed her A.Mus.A in Classical Guitar in 1989 at the Conservatorium of Music in Sydney, completing an Associate degree in Music Teaching the same year.

Julie was an original member of the North Shore Guitar Society and has performed in ensembles, summer schools, master classes and guitar orchestras. Having completed her Bachelor of Education in 2006, Julie is currently teaching music at Wauchope High School, runs the *Fretful Fingers* guitar ensemble and enjoys singing in Cantorus.
