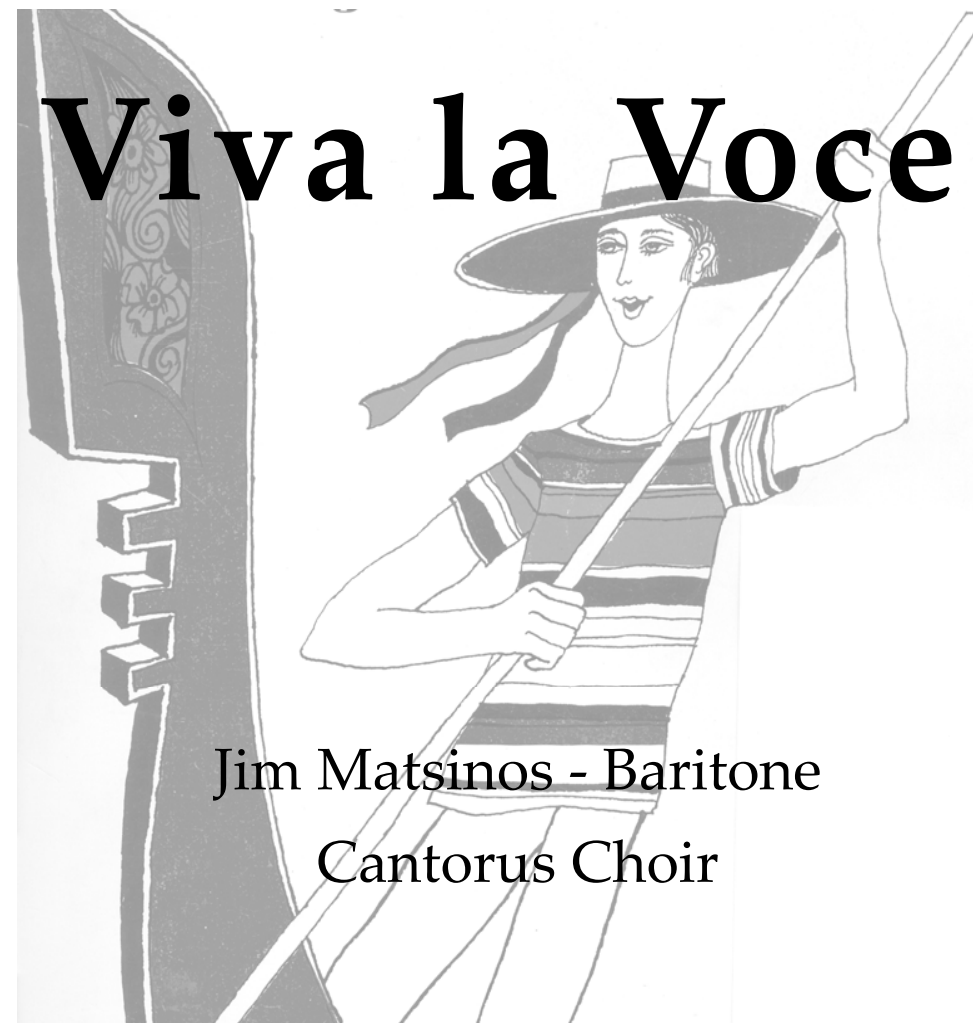

A Musical Partnership

Jim Matsinos and Robyn Ryan have long combined their musical talents to enrich our community. In 1984 they produced *The Pirates of Penzance* as the first production for the opening of the Players Theatre. They worked together with the Port Macquarie Players in a concert recital and performed for the official opening of the new Court House. They have appeared in numerous recitals, including twice in Brisbane and Port Macquarie, raising money for charities such as Life Education and the Cancer Council. Their last production in Port Macquarie was *The Mikado* before the demolition of the old Civic Centre.

Jim has worked closely with Robyn in directing a number of choral presentations for Hastings Choristers over the years, as well as performing as a soloist and as a member of the choir with the basses. Some memorable moments include Jim singing the Bass roles in Mozart's Coronation Mass and the Faure Requiem. Fans of the Choristers will remember *Musical Magic* as one of their most popular concerts, with Jim assisting Robyn enormously with the organisation and, of course, being one of the soloists. Rumour has it there could be another musical from this pair next year!
